STATEMENT: Re- Haldimand County Council motion

Six Nations Confederacy Chiefs Council Negotiating team

The Six Nations Haudenosaunee Confederacy Chiefs Council (SNHCCC) have been in talks with Ontario over the maintenance and care of Kanonhstaton, Six Nations lands adjacent to the town of Caledonia formerly known as the Douglas Creek Estates, since 2006.

While the site itself remains peaceful, there have been issues of mischief recently that the SNHCCC's Haudenosaunee Development Institute has been working with Ontario to address.

It has just come to the attention of the Confederacy Chiefs' negotiating team that Haldimand County Council is engaged in internal discussions on the former roads on the site and wishes to re-open those unfinished areas. The Chief's negotiating committee are in discussions with Ontario about Haldimand County's decision.

While we have not received any notification from Haldimand County Council over this issues, our team is more than willing to open discussions with them on their concerns and hopes Haldimand County Council is willing to discuss these matters in peace and friendship, before any attempt to remove anything from Kanonhstaton is undertaken.
